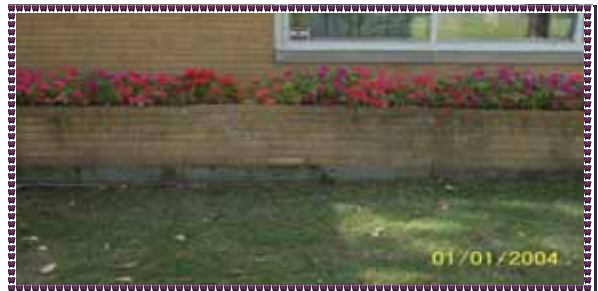
Flowers in Bloom
